Registration/ Event Credential

Participants are required to bring their 2022 RACE Events Competition Licence as an official ID.

Registration hours:

Friday, June 10, 2022 – 7:30 am to 5:00 pm at the SMP Registration Centre
To speed up the process, priority is given to test day registration first thing in the morning.

Saturday, June 11, 2022 – 7:30 am to 4:00 pm at the SMP Registration Centre
Sunday, June 12, 2022 – 7:30 am to 4:00 pm at the SMP Registration Centre

Reminder: Teams are allowed 2 crew members (free). Riders must give the names at registration. Crew members must register during registration hours to get a proper credential.

Additional class registration or changes must be done BEFORE 10:30 am.

Note: **Fast Lane Check-In** will be available for participants who pre-registered and previously signed all required documents (Medical Self-Declaration, Annual Waiver & Concussion Code of Conduct) and have their own transponder.

Transponder Rentals

Transponders are mandatory for all race events.

It is strongly recommended to acquire your own transponder. For competitors who wish to rent a transponder, the weekend fee is \$40 (tx incl). **A deposit of \$200 will be required and refunded when the transponder is returned.**

Transponders shall be returned on Sunday at the registration centre before 5 pm.

Move-In

Participants can move-in starting:

Friday - Test Day

Please take note that a special group dedicated to the PRO track will be accessible during the Racing group only. Check schedule for specific times and paddock announcements. Participants who wish to register for the test day must do so online. See <https://super-series.ca/registration/>.

Paddock Speed

Speed Limit in the Paddock is 10km/h. Speeding or wheelies in the paddock are strictly forbidden and are subject to fines.

Technical Inspection

Technical inspections are done at the Official Super Series Technical area located behind the Fast garage. Inspections must be done prior to on-track sessions and will be available all weekend, starting Friday.

Technical inspection must be completed, and an inspection sticker affixed to the motorcycle before the first session and after medical clearance.

Official Notice Board

The official Notice Board will be located at the Super Series Technical area.

Riders Meetings

Riders Meetings are mandatory. Super Series Riders Meetings will be held in the SMP grandstand.

Pit Lane Rules

Maximum Speed limit in pit lane is 50km/h unless stated otherwise by a race official. Riders must obey officials at all times.

A maximum of 2 crew persons per motorcycle, for the purpose of signaling, are permitted at the pit lane wall during the Super Series on-track sessions. To be in Pit Lane, you need to wear the proper attire for safety reasons: closed shoes, long pants.

Practice, Qualifying and Race – Horns/Announcements

A horn will sound or an announcement will be made prior to the beginning of all official Track Sessions informing the competitors that they may leave their assigned Paddock Parking and proceed to the Pre-Grid.

Pre-Grid will be located behind the SMP Grandstand. Tire warmers are allowed if self sufficient with power. All Crew members must vacate the pre-grid area at the 1-minute notice.
